



Lake Markers

- Prior to the May long weekend, ensure that markers are placed according to the most recent rock marker map (currently 24 markers – numbered A through X). Markers must indicate:
 - Private Property
 - Contact information if found
 - Reflective tape (sides and top)
 - Floating rope is recommended to attach the marker to the anchor
- Post-Thanksgiving weekend, remove summer markers
 - Replace each summer marker with a plain jug for ease of locating ropes the following spring and to guide boaters during off season
- Maintain markers during the season above. If a marker is reported missing, ensure that the marker which has come loose is re-attached and/or replaced in a timely manner.
- Monitor emails received from the website address, rocks@steenburglake.com and take action as necessary
- Ensure that sufficient supplies are on hand for timely repair or replacement of markers
